Driving: From Ft. Worth: Take 35W North to the 1171 exit (I think it's exit 74 but am not certain.) Take a right to go east, it's about a mile or so to the entrance on the right. Take the road that goes into the airport and take the first left. (Don't forget to stop and check final for landing aircraft prior to driving past the runway.) Take a right on the taxiway, yielding right of way to aircraft, the blue hangar cafe is on the left where all the cars are parked.

From Dallas: Take 35E North to Lewisville. Take the 1171 exit, follow it past Hwy 377 (Denton Highway). Cross the railroad tracks and the airport entrance will be a few miles on the left. See directions above from there.

Flying: NW Regional is 5.7 miles NE of Alliance Airport. Watch for Class D airspace, Class B floors, and commercial airliners in-bound DFW from the Northwest. They can be as low as 3500 ft. NWR (52F) freq is 122.9. NWR is typically busy on Saturdays, so listen for traffic and keep your eyes open.

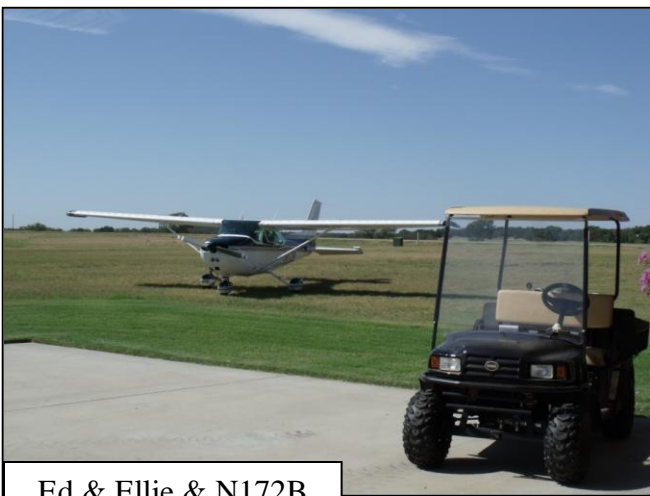
