### **Possible Flying Routes to the 2012 Convention in Ogden, UT**

Gilbert Pierce wrote: "Planning to go north of Denver along the Laramie, Rawlins, Rock Springs, Fort Bridger, Evanston, Morgan County or depending on Wx just cut across the mountains Evanston to Ogden."

John Parrish, Convention Chair, responded, "Your plan along I-80 sounds good, that's the way I come across also. From Rock Springs I go direct to OGD over the mountains and that puts me just North of Evanston, then continue west and once over the ridge line you can start picking up the ATIS. I start letting down over Pineview Reservoir and fly north to go through North Ogden Canyon pass to lose altitude, once through the pass you can see the Ogden Airport to the South and make your initial call up from there, this give more time to lose altitude and get set up, this is what works for me. Info: When you see the reservoir, you will see Ogden Canyon directly ahead, once through this pass, Hill AFB will be to the left and Ogden Airport to the right just over the city."
