Unzip the downloaded file. Open either the "North" or "South" .tif file with an image editor. If using Windows Paint, go to Image> Stretch/Skew then reduce the horizontal and vertical by the same percentages to decrease the file size to what you desire. Then "Save As..." the .tif file as a .jpg image file. You now have a digital version of any FAA sectional for your iPad, laptop, Nook, Droid, or other electronic device.
